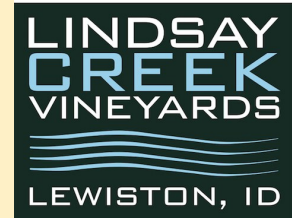

## Important Information

- Must be 21 years of age or older.
- Some Gravel Trails
- Riders may arrive at the camp site on Friday, July 8th no earlier than 9 a.m. There are no RV electrical or water hookups on site. Toilets and showers are available within walking distance of camp.
- Forty open stalls are available on a first-come first-serve basis. All campers are required to clean their camp sites of litter and manure.
- No dogs allowed on the trail. Dogs in camp must be on a leash at all times and kept 100 feet from dining area.
- No stallions allowed.
- A coggins test and health certificate are required to enter the State of Idaho.

## Directions

Travel east out of Moscow on Highway 8. You will go approximately 29 miles, passing through Troy and Deary. The grounds are just past milepost 29 on the left.

If you get to Helmer, you have gone one mile too far!
